# Background

Integrated Care Systems (ICS) represent a radical overhaul in health and social care design and delivery (Health and Care Act 2022). As systems we aim to develop healthy places to live and work, driving equity in life chances and health outcomes for everyone. A cornerstone of this is education and development, not just for staff, but for those forming grassroot support to those at the end of their lives. Three large systems in the Midlands have combined to create an interactive, intuitive education and training platform to support this delivery.

- underpinned by best practice information
- based on a blended approach.
